

# DROP OFF CENTER - 2026 SEASON

**Saturday Hours:** April 11 thru November 21, 2026\* 7:30 AM – 3:30 PM

**Wednesday Hours:** April 15 thru September 2, 2026\* 3:00 PM - 7:00 PM

Disposal fees are due at time of service. NO cash is accepted. Payment is by check or credit card<sup>1</sup> only. Residents should bring their own pens for filling out checks.

## Acceptable Items - No Charge

<b>Yard Waste:</b>	Leaves, branches & grass clippings. (Limit one 6-wheel dump truck of brush.)
<b>Plastics:</b>	<b>All</b> rigid plastics with or without a recycling symbol. Any size accepted. (NO Styrofoam, NO plastic tarps, NO inflatable toys, NO plastic wrap or bags.)
<b>Clothing and Textiles:</b>	Any reusable item of clothing, draperies, and linens for the Salvation Army.
<b>Corrugated Cardboard:</b>	Packing boxes and other packaging cardboard - packed flat.
<b>Single Stream Recycling:</b>	Acceptable paper, plastic bottles & containers, cans, glass (NO plastic bags.)
<b>Rechargeable Batteries:</b>	From power tools, cell-phones, calculators, and laptops - Please give to attendants.
<b>Automobile Batteries:</b>	Please give to attendants.
<b>Fluorescent Bulbs:</b>	All tube types and CFL's (spiral) – Unbroken - Please give to attendants.
<b>Cell Phones:</b>	Please give to attendants.

## Acceptable Items - **Fee Charged – Payment is by CHECK & CREDIT CARD ONLY<sup>1</sup>. No Cash is accepted.** <sup>1</sup>Convenience Fee Will Apply

<b>Scrap Metal:</b>	\$5 per load – Aluminum, steel, brass & copper. Virtually any item made from metal will be recycled <b>except those containing Freon. (No refrigerators or air conditioners accepted.)</b>	
<b>Propane Tanks:</b>	20 lb. tank - \$4.00, Small 1 lb. tank - No charge.	
<b>Construction Debris and Bulky Items:</b>	\$24 per cubic yard, Minimum \$7 up to 55-gallon barrel. 6 ft. Pickup Truck \$36, 8 ft. Pickup Truck \$48	
	<b>Acceptable Items</b>	Pressure treated lumber, fiberglass, cement, plastic piping, wiring, sheetrock, carpet, lumber, other building materials & bulky household items.
	<b>Non-Acceptable Items</b>	Railroad ties, asbestos, paint cans & gas cans. <u>NO</u> liquids of any kind.
<b>Furniture:</b>	Small Items \$7 each.	Chairs, twin mattresses, etc.
	Large Items \$14 each.	Sofa, tables, full mattresses, etc.
<b>Tires:</b>	4 Free with car registration.	
	Additional tires \$2 without rim, \$3 with rim.	
<b>Electronics:</b>	\$7 computers, monitors, TV's ≤ 20", microwaves (No charge for mice, keyboards and wiring.)	
	\$14 commercial size fax/copier machines, TV's > 20"	
<b>Overflow Bags:</b>	\$3 each for a 30-gallon overflow bag used for curbside trash collection.	

**Directions** - Located at 13 Recovery Way off of West Road: From the junction of Route 102 and Route 128 Mammoth Road – Follow Route 102 West towards Hudson approximately 3 miles to next set of lights – Take a right onto West Road – approximately 1 mile take a left onto Recovery Way to the Drop Off Center.
