



LONDONDERRY FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Londonderry Fire Prevention Code and the New Hampshire State Fire Code regulate the use and storage of grills in the following manner:

2021 NFPA 1 - section 10.10.6 states:

10.10.6 Cooking Equipment.

10.10.6.1

For other than one- and two-family dwellings, no hibachi, grill, or other similar devices used for cooking, heating, or any other purpose shall be used or kindled on any balcony, under any overhanging portion, or within 10 ft (3 m) of any structure.

10.10.6.2

For other than one-and two-family dwellings, no hibachi, grill, or other similar devices used for cooking shall be stored on a balcony.

Multifamily and commercial buildings cannot have grills kindled within 10 (ten) feet of the structure. Decks are considered part of a structure therefore other than electric grills; grills cannot be stored or kindled on a deck/balcony.

If you are aware of anyone in violation of this law please notify your condo association, building management company, or the Londonderry Fire Department.
