Pursuant to the right to know law (RSA- 91A). I am requesting public access, within five business days, to the governmental records reasonably described as follows:


All records, no matter what form, including but not limited to, printed documents, electronic documents, emails, or any other form of records regarding the Lions organization reimbursing the taxpayers \$80,000 for repairs paid for by the town out of the maintenance trust fund. While I understand this is a town building, the lease required the Lions organization to pay for all repairs and maintenance. Therefore, I believe this to be a misappropriation of taxpayer funds. I am looking for the records as described above for the period from January 1, 2021 to present.
