Mr. Bielinski,

I acknowledge receipt of the "Right to Know" request you handed me approximately 4.5 hours ago at this evening's meeting of the Londonderry Town Council.

You request:

*All records, no matter what form, including but not limited to, printed documents, electronic documents, emails, or any other form of records regarding the Lions organization reimbursing the taxpayers \$80,000 for repairs paid for by the town out of the maintenance trust fund.*

As the town has never seriously considered pursuing the Lions for money the Town Council voted to invest in the Lions' Hall, a town asset, there are no governmental records responsive to your request as phrased. However, out of an abundance of caution, and resolving the imprecision of your request, as phrased, in favor of disclosure, I attach the one governmental record which generally addresses this issue.

No documents were withheld under any exemption or privilege.
