Your Right-to-Know request submitted on **December 23, 2023**, as listed below, has been filled with all documents found responsive. Below you will find a link to the **remaining** documents found responsive to your request.

Description of Request:

“-A copy of Town Manager Malaguti's ethics complaint to the NH House of Representatives RE State Representative Kristine Perez interactions with Kristen Grages. **[Part A]**

-emails and other correspondence and work product between Town Officials relevant the Town Manager's complaint against Rep Perez **[Part B]**

-Any internal correspondence regarding recording meetings of the Supervisors of the Checklist, EXCEPT email correspondence previously sent to Jonathan Esposito ([REDACTED]) **[Part C]**

-IT, administrative, building plan, or Access Center documents and correspondence sufficient to establish what audio/visual recording capacity exists in the work area within and adjacent to the Town Clerk's office. **[Part D]**

Scope of records search is Dec. 2022 to present.”

Response:

When responding to an RSA 91-A request, the Town complies with the definition of government records stated in RSA 91-A:1-a:

any information created, accepted, or obtained by, or on behalf of, any public body, or a quorum or majority thereof, or any public agency in furtherance of its official function. Without limiting the foregoing, the term ‘governmental records’ includes any written communication or other information, whether in paper, electronic, or other physical form, received by a quorum or majority of a public body in furtherance of its official function, whether at a meeting or outside a meeting of the body. The term ‘governmental records’ shall also include the term ‘public records.’

The Town also complies with the exemptions stated in RSA 91-A:5 and those created by case law.

Records Found Responsive:

All records found responsive to **Part A** were delivered on Tuesday, January 2, 2024.

Included in the folder linked below are all governmental records found responsive to **Part B** and **Part C** of your request. Please note that this includes video files that were shared by Town Manager Michael Malaguti with Speaker of the House Sherman Packard through Dropbox's internal sharing mechanism. (Folder: "Video 9-20") **Part B contains a single redaction to comply with RSA 91-A:5, IV, "confidential, commercial, or financial information...and files whose**

disclosure would constitute an invasion of privacy” to remove a personal email address. *Part C* contains no redactions.

A single record was identified as responsive to your request in ***Part D***, however that record is exempted from the provisions of RSA 91-A pursuant to RSA 91-A:5, VI, “Records pertaining to matters relating to the preparation for and the carrying out of all emergency functions, including training to carry out such functions, developed by local or state safety officials that are directly intended to thwart a deliberate act that is intended to result in widespread or severe damage to property or widespread injury or loss of life” and/or RSA 91-A:5, XI, “Records pertaining to information technology systems, including...detailed network diagrams, or other materials, the release of which would make public security details that would aid an attempted security breach or circumvention of law as to the items assessed.” Accordingly, the record will not be produced.
