

**Chapter XVIII – DISTURBANCE AND/OR WORK CONDUCTED WITHIN THE
TOWN’S RIGHT OF WAY OR EASEMENT**

SECTION I AUTHORITY

- A. The Director of Public Works and Engineering shall be authorized to review and recommend all construction, repairs, erection of traffic control or temporary construction signs, or other work or actions necessary to conduct work or correct any disturbance to the Town’s Right of Way or Easement of the Town of Londonderry.

SECTION II PROCEDURE

- A. No person shall displace, break or otherwise remove the pavement or ground in any part of the Town’s Right of Way or Easement of the Town of Londonderry, erect any staging, place or deposit any loam, stone, gravel, concrete, brick, timber or other materials thereon without first obtaining a written permit from the Department of Public Works and Engineering.
- B. No person shall erect, place or raise any signs, billboards or other obstruction on or within the Town’s Right of Way.
- C. All construction, repairs, erection of traffic control or temporary construction signs, or other work or action shall be conducted in accordance with the rules/regulations and specifications required by the Department of Public Works and Engineering.

SECTION III PENALTY

- A. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable to the Town for all damages to such Right of Way or Easement of the Town and for all expense incurred by the Town in removing any unauthorized construction, obstruction, sign or other material from Town’s Right of Way or Easement; and correcting or repairing any defects or damage caused by such violation in addition to the penalties prescribed elsewhere in the Londonderry Municipal Code.
