

Chapter XV - LOITERING AND BLOCKAGE OF PUBLIC WAYS

SECTION I AUTHORITY

- A. This ordinance shall be enforceable pursuant to RSA 644:2 and as amended from time to time.

SECTION II PROCEDURE

- A. No person shall block or cause to be blocked any public sidewalk, street, or other public way, in accordance with the Londonderry Traffic Code, Section 7; nor shall any group of persons assemble in such a manner as to impede or block the orderly progress of pedestrian or vehicular traffic within the Town of Londonderry.
- B. No person shall sit, stand or loiter in or about any street, sidewalk, municipal land or building or any other public place in the Town of Londonderry after having been requested by any owner, tenant or custodian thereof, or by any police officer, to depart therefrom.
- C. No person shall sit, stand or loiter in or about the doors, windows or entrance to any store, shop, office, house, public hall, theater or other public building in the Town of Londonderry, except the owners or tenants thereof after having been requested by any owner, tenant or custodian thereof, or by any police officer, to depart therefrom.
