

CHAPTER VII - PUBLIC PERFORMANCES

SECTION I AUTHORITY

- A. All provisions of New Hampshire Statute (RSA 286) relevant to public entertainment and all amendments thereto are hereby adopted and are in full force in the Town.

SECTION II LICENSE REQUIRED

- A. No person shall produce or exhibit any such entertainment in accordance with RSA 286 without first obtaining a license from the Town Clerk.
- B. The fee for such a license shall be the sum of one hundred (\$100) dollars, is non refundable and may be waived by the Town Council.

SECTION III NOTICE TO HEALTH/SAFETY OFFICERS

- A. The applicant must notify, in writing, the Fire Department, Police Department and Health Officer of the Town prior to obtaining any license for public performance(s).
- B. The above referenced Town Departments shall forward any recommendations for remediation of safety violations to the Town Council prior to any license being issued.
